Keeping your NOS clean - Single Sign-On

More and more organizations are choosing to setup single sign-on to PeopleSoft Apps using Active Directory. This can facilitate productivity gains and eliminate the need for users to maintain different sets of passwords. The downside to this approach is the burden it places on Active Directory, which should ideally be kept unencumbered to maintain responsiveness for its real function; acting as your network operating system (NOS). In this session, Identity Management expert James La Brash explores a strategy to accomplish Single Sign-On using Active Directory Lightweight Directory Services (AD LDS) without stressing the Active Directory instance that should be running your network.

Basic Directions

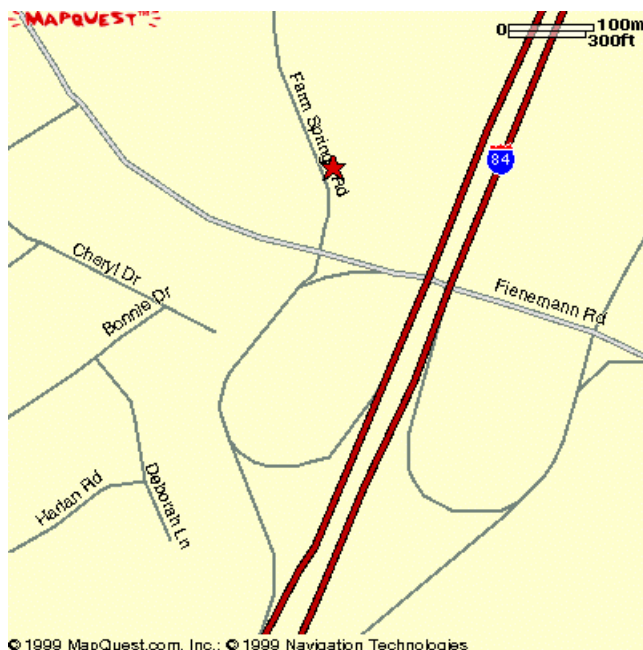
Take Route 84 to Exit 37, Fienemann Rd. (from either direction)
