Vendor Managed Inventory (VMI) with World and EnterpriseOne

In today's changing markets many firms are looking at Vendor Managed Inventory as a marketing competitive advantage or are being pressured by their customers to provide VMI. Regardless of the reason VMI will require the firm to a move from traditional Forecasting / Planning / Execution / Finance to a different Operational Model. This new VMI Model means shifting traditional responsibilities, impact on corporate Cash Management and Inventory investment, a change in monitoring the customer's sales / inventory movements and defining Rules Of The Road between you and the Customer on how VMI will operate are required. As firms move in this direction they need to review there present systems capabilities. They need to determine if updates or upgrades are required to their support the VMI initiative. In many cases firms are not aware of there currently systems capabilities to support VMI. Firms are asking the question "What are the real requirements and investments to upgrade their systems" to support VMI. This session is designed to highlight:

What is VMI and what areas of the firm does it impact the most.

Define an Operational Agreement that can be executed between you and a potential customer. How can that agreement work with existing systems? What new systems will need to be brought on line to make it operational? What internal operation will get effected by the agreement?

Reviewing that agreement against existing systems

How can you use current systems to get your VMI project jump started today?

The elements required to define and plan for additional systems or upgraded might be necessary to bring VMI fully operational at your firm.

Basic Directions

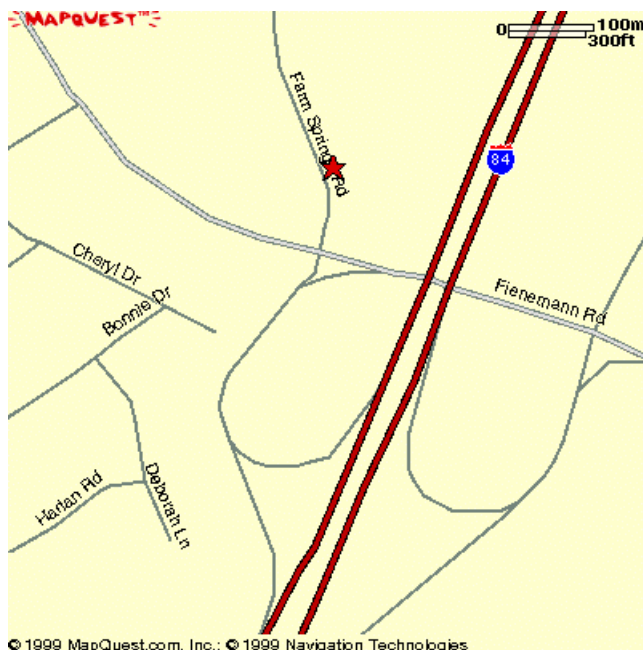
Take Route 84 to Exit 37, Fienemann Rd. (from either direction)
